

Specifications for Gaps in Care

EPSDT-Developmental Screening

Purpose: The purpose of this measure is to identify and track members who are due for a Developmental Screening.

<p>Which Members are Included? (Denominator)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Members with active coverage with the insurance plan as of the last day of the reporting period • Members who turned 18 months of age prior to the last 60 days of the reporting period • Members who turned 30 months of age prior to the last 60 days of the reporting period
<p>What Provider Data is Included? (Numerator)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For 18 Months: At least one (1) developmental screening performed by a PCP practitioner between 17 months & 21 months of age • For 30 Months: At least one (1) developmental screening performed by a PCP practitioner between 27 months & 33 months of age
<p>Provider Communication Tools (How providers receive the information)</p>	<p>Claims data is evaluated on a monthly basis for all members. In the event that there is no claim for this specific service, the system generates an automatic notice of care gap. Care Gap status notification is provided by and accessible through NaviNet via:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Member Eligibility “pop-up” alerts • Care Gap Query Reports • Member Clinical Summary Reports • Monthly NaviNet report updates reflect Gaps In Care for PCP practice panel membership. • Panel membership results include indicators for this Gaps In Care measure as “Missing”, “Up-to-date” or “Overdue.”
